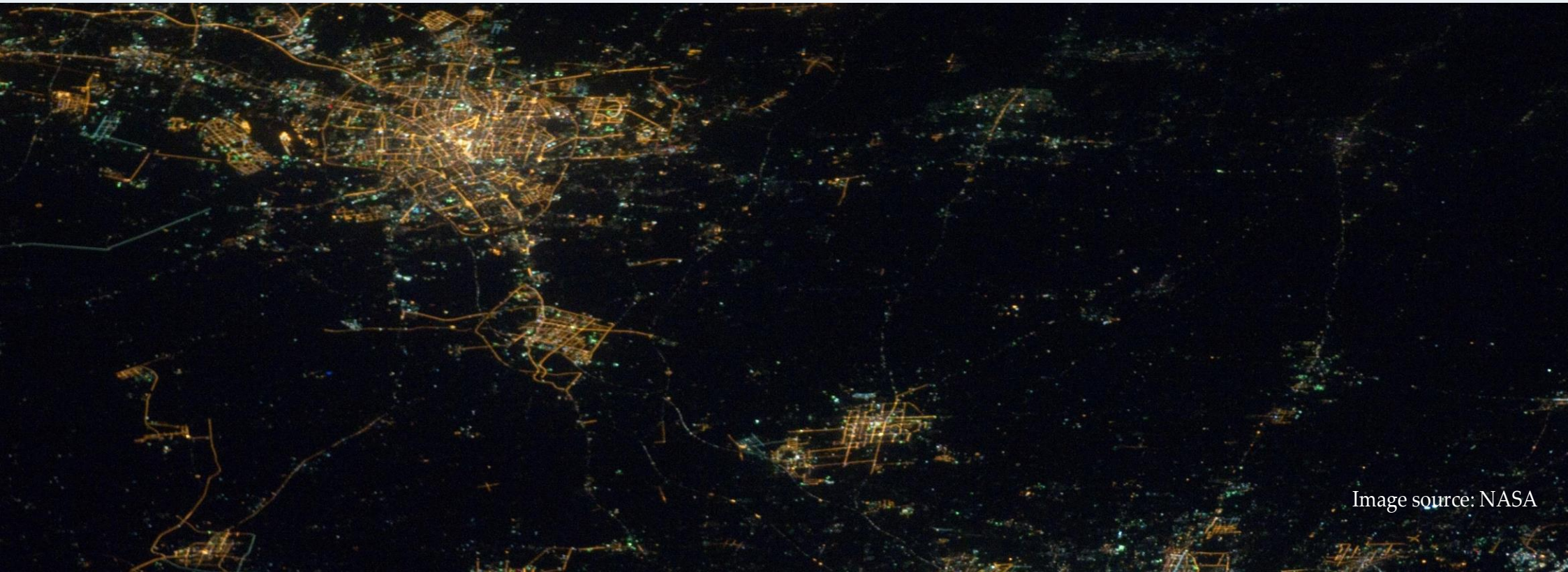

### Spatial dynamics of Sustainable Urban Transitions: evidence from China and Mexico

Prof. **Ehtisham Ahmad** is directing a project on **Sustainable Transition in China and Mexico** at the Grantham Research Institute, London School of Economics and Political Science (LSE). He worked with the ADB on Financing Sustainable Growth for consideration for the Chinese 14<sup>th</sup> Five Year Plan. During the past decade, he has been Visiting Professor at the LSE, Pao Yu-Kong Professor at Zhejiang University, Senior Fellow at the Centre for Development Research, University of Bonn, and Senior Fellow of the Chinese Academy of Fiscal Science/Ministry of Finance Research Institute. Mostrecently, he has been advising the European Commission and OECD on Conflict Resolution and Sustainable Growth in the post-conflict reconstruction in Libya. While at the IMF (1990-2010) he led several technical assistance missions to support fiscal reform in China, countries in the former Soviet Union, Indonesia, Egypt, Nigeria, and Mexico. He was a member of the World Bank staff team for the 1990 World Development Report on Poverty. He was Director of the Development Economics Research Program, LSE. He has written extensively on multilevel finance, taxation, fiscalmanagement, social policy, poverty alleviation, and spatial development.
