2nd Workshop – Asian Emerging Economies

Established in 2014 and based in Turin, OEET -Turin Centre on Emerging Economies is an independent, non-profit centre dedicated to the study and monitoring of major emerging economies and to the dissemination of results of economic analyses and information to firms, institutions and the general public.

The 2nd workshop organized by OEET will be held in Turin in **November 27-28, 2015**.

OEET invites abstract submissions for paper presentation in one of the following sessions:

1) Inclusive Development in Emerging Asia. In this Century several Asian countries have registered a high rate of economic growth, but have encountered different degrees of difficulties with income and wealth distribution problems, mass poverty, access to education and decent health care services. The aim of this session is to analyze the problems of inclusive development in Asian countries and to discuss alternative economic policies.

2) Global value chains, trade and multinational networks in Asia. Trade patterns are shaped by global and regional value chains, as well as by production and R&D networks involving and proposed by multinational corporations. This panel will analyze ongoing trends in Asian emerging economies, shading light on key issues, perspectives and policy implications.

The acceptance will be announced within two weeks. A maximum of four papers and ten posters will be selected.
